II. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this request is to do the battery Installation, Removal & Disposal, during normal hours for an APC Smart-UPS 3 kVA, SURTA 3000XL, Serial #QS1404141332 for the Embassy of the Argentine Republic in the United States of America located at 1600 New Hampshire Ave, N.W., Washington DC, in accordance with the technical specifications and other documents governing this request for proposals.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

The scope includes the supply of labor and all the necessary elements for the service to be complete and adequate for its purpose, in accordance with the trade's rules, the technical specifications and the documentation governing this invitation to bid. If the technical specifications or bidding documents do not list all the necessary work to achieve the result or the necessary elements to perform them, the Contractor must perform and/or provide them, without the right to demand any additional payment.

The work shall be complete, comply with the local rules and regulations in force, all necessary insurance and conform to the trade's rules according to the purpose for which it is to be performed.

3. TERM

The term for the execution of the works detailed in this contract is THIRTY (30) DAYS counted from the day after the Purchase Order is received, subject to manufacturer lead time.

4. INSURANCE

The Co-contractor must obtain all insurances related to labor risks, third party and property damage prior to the commencement of the work.

5. CLEANING

The Co-contractor must maintain daily cleanliness at the site, including the final disposal of waste and debris generated by the execution of the works.

6. GUARANTEE

The Co-contractor must guarantee the works for SIXTY (60) days for labor, and ONE (1) year for the batteries from the day after the Final Acceptance.

7. DESCRIPTION OF WORK

This items includes the following tasks:

- Batteries must be hermetic and require no maintenance.

- Its nominal voltage and current values must be equivalent to those existing in the uninterruptible power unit.
- All batteries must be of the same type, same manufacturer, same age and capacity.
- It is required to review the internal electrical connections for the batteries, which are in correct conditions for their reconnection, if not, they must be conditioned or repaired.
