



Frances Allyn Morgan  
Rochester, MN, 1851 - Winona, MN, 1933



Egresada de la escuela normal de Winona, llegó a la Argentina en 1877 para asumir la dirección de la escuela normal de Paraná. En 1881 regresó a Estados Unidos, donde se casó con Stephen W. Morgan y siguió dedicándose a la enseñanza. Desde Winona convocó a un contingente de nueve maestras que viajaron a la Argentina conocidas como “las maestras de Winona”.



After graduating from the Winona Normal School, she arrived in Argentina in 1877 to head the Paraná Normal School. In 1881 she returned to the United States, where she married Stephen W. Morgan and continued to teach. While living in Winona, she brought together a group of nine teachers who traveled to Argentina and were known as “the teachers from Winona”.
