Ballina, Ireland, 1844 - Buenos Aires, 1903



Siendo niña emigró con su familia a Estados Unidos. Llegó a la Argentina en 1877 y su primer destino fue Tucumán, donde contrajo paludismo. Se instaló en Buenos Aires a partir de 1878, para trabajar como vicedirectora y directora de la escuela privada de Agnes Trégent, donde continuó hasta su muerte.



As a child, she immigrated with her family to the United States. She arrived in Argentina in 1877 and her first destination was Tucumán, where she contracted malaria. She settled in Buenos Aires in 1878, to work as vice-director and director of the Agnes Trégent private school, where she continued working until her death.
