



Theodora Gay Schlosser
Malone, NY, 1860 - Recife, Brazil, 1892



Llegó a la Argentina en 1881 traída por su hermana Mary Gay McMillan. Trabajó en Catamarca y luego en Jujuy con su amiga de Malone, Mary Jeanette Stevens. Tuvo a su cargo la escuela modelo de Jujuy. Se casó con el ingeniero austríaco Fernando Schlosser. En 1892 partió con su esposo a Río de Janeiro, donde contrajo fiebre amarilla y murió.



She arrived in Argentina in 1881 brought by her sister, Mary Gay McMillan. She worked in Catamarca, then in Jujuy with Mary Jeanette Stevens, a friend from Malone. She was in charge of the Jujuy model school. She married Fernando Schlosser, an Austrian engineer. In 1892 she left with her husband for Rio de Janeiro, where she contracted yellow fever and died.
